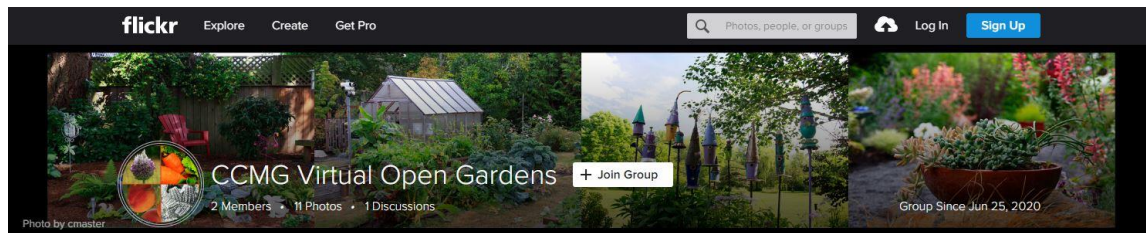


flickr photo sharing webpage

1. Sign up for an account on [flickr.com](https://www.flickr.com)
 - a. After you have your account started you may want to join the CCMG Virtual Open Garden Group (step 3) before you upload your photos, since it may take a day or so for Sharon to act on your request.
2. Edit and upload the photos of your garden.
 - a. Use the cloud with arrow icon to upload your photos
 - b. Your photos will be in a list called a Photostream.
 - c. After uploading your photos make a New Album for your garden photos. (link is on the right side of the page). Here you can batch organize and edit the titles and descriptions of your photos to create a story.



3. Join the [CCMG Virtual Open Gardens](#) group.
 - a. When the group comes up click the +Join blue box
 - b. You will be asked to contact the admin (Sharon Andrews) by writing in the square. Just type in Please add me. Sharon will receive a message and add you to the group.
 - c. Once you have been added you can add your photos to the group and join discussions in the group.
4. Tips:
 - a. To simplify viewing we recommend that you organize your photos in albums.
 - b. Don't forget to add titles and captions describing the photos to tell the story of your garden.
 - c. You can also sign up to follow the Clackamas County Master Gardeners profile to get notified with we post new items to the Photostream.
